Cwm Arian Renewable Energy (CARE) is a community benefit society based in Crymych, Pembrokeshire. Our vision is to see 'thriving communities, connected to nature and each other, enjoying environments rich in life'.

We began as a group of volunteers sharing a common interest in protecting the natural environment, supporting the local rural economy to prevent or relieve poverty, and investing the benefits from our activities locally.

We are seeking casual help to promote our Energy Services to the public.

Job Description

The summer season is always a busy one for our Energy team, as they visit shows and events across West Wales to talk to people about the energy services we offer to householders; from general energy efficiency advice, to full bespoke retrofit assessments.

We are seeking helpers to attend events through the summer (until end of August 2025) to speak to people about these services, and give a helping hand to householders who need support to make their homes cosier, lower their bills and reduce their carbon footprint. This could be larger events such as county shows to the smaller activities such as coffee mornings.

Knowledge of domestic energy efficiency or a keen willingness to learn are essential to this role - training and resources will be provided. This role will suit you if you are enthusiastic, approachable and an excellent communicator, and ideally a Welsh-speaker or learner.

Although this casual vacancy is currently until the end of August 2025, the right person may find a more permanent position or ongoing work with Cwm Arian.

Job terms

- **Hours** = up to 2 days/week (15 hours), with some weekend and evening work required.
- Salary = £18.57 per hour (N.B CARE currently operates a flat pay structure)
- **Contract term** = starting immediately, in a self-employed/freelance capacity, with work available until end of August 2025
- **Expenses** = for mileage, event entry, resources etc. Use of leased company vehicle is sometimes possible.
- **Hardware/software** = CARE can supply IT equipment if needed and will support with software needs where necessary.
- Working location = willingness to do some work from rented offices in Crymych is ideal, to ensure regular in-person contact with colleagues, and you must also be able to work remotely as there is a significant requirement to travel to deliver the work.
